HEMOPHILIA?

Hemophilia is a congenital bleeding disorder caused by the deficiency of certain clotting proteins in the blood. Classical Hemophilia or Hemophilia - A is the commonest (80%) caused by factor VIII deficiency followed by Christmas disease or Hemophilia - B due to factor IX deficiency. Hemophilia is a complex disorder that can be associated with significant morbidity & lifelong treatment. Repeated bleeding into joints & muscles can lead to the development of chronic joint disease. These



individuals may suffer from joint pain, loss of range of motion & crippling musculoskeletal deformity & disability, all of which impair their quality of life & have implications on education, employment, productivity causing economical & psychosocial stress. The appropriate management of Hemophilia is key to minimizing & preventing long-term issues that can contribute to the higher cost. As per WHO, the prevalence of Hemophilia is estimated to be about 1 in 10,000 births, on that of severe form of the disease to be about 6 per 1,00,000. According to this, there are over 1,00,000 people with Hemophilia (PWH) in India & about 6000 PwH in Karnataka state but only about 20 % of them are identified & registered by Hemophilia societies.



Karnataka Hemophilia Society, Davangere (KHS) is a Non-Profit Organization working for the welfare of PwH and related Bleeding Disorders since 1989-90. KHS is founded by Dr.Suresh Hanagavadi who himself is a Person with Hemophilia. His maternal uncle's death to life-threatening bleed for want of treatment made him to become doctor & commit towards establishing Hemophilia care services in Karnataka state. It is registered under Society's Act, 1960 and affiliated to Hemophilia Federation India, New Delhi, which is a satellite body of World Federation of Hemophilia, Canada. Karnataka Hemophilia Society has identified more than 900 Patients with Hemophilia & other Bleeding Disorders & providing Diagnosis, Treatment and Rehabilitation services to the patients referred from different parts of the state, mainly from the Districts of Central and North Karnataka.

Hemophilia being a lesser-known genetic disorder needs a focussed and sincere effort to both create awareness and train the concerned health personnel. The disease being a low burden high-cost disease the interventions from the government are many a times constrained. This is when organisations like Karnataka Haemophilia Society Davangere join hands with the government to fill in the gaps in giving a continuum of care to the often-neglected group of patients. In this direction KHS had organized Capacity Building Program - 2 days Hands on training for Clinicians, Pathologists, Laboratory Technicians, Nurses & Physiotherapists at all District Hospitals in the month of February, 2023 (weekly) to empower them with Diagnosis & Management Skills to improve the quality of Haemophilia care.

The 2-days training on haemophilia was a well-structured program imparting practical skills for Physicians & Paediatricians in Diagnosis & Management, Laboratory Diagnostic skills for Pathologists, Laboratory Diagnostic skills for Laboratory Technicians, practical skills to Staff Nurses & Promoting coordination of comprehensive Haemophilia care and practical skills in Rehabilitation for Physiotherapists. It was a comprehensive workshop encompassing all cadre of health personnel involved in haemophilia care. The arrangements at the training venue were well planned. The response to the training from our district hospitals was very good and there was a strengthening of their skills. The two-day workshop was inaugurated by one of the philanthropists Smt. Kiruvadi Girijamma who is also the Honorary President, KHS. She recalled the initial days of struggle in setting up this centre for PWH. In this regard Dr Suresh Hanagavadi and their team have left no stone unturned in successfully establishing this centre with support from philanthropists and government. This Worksop is one of the many activities they undertake in stiving to make the lives of PWH better. haemophilia care is not only medical treatment but needs a holistic approach with both medical and paramedical care which this centre is providing. Patients from across many districts avail the services from this centre. I would like to congratulate Dr Suresh Hanagavadi and team for organising this very important training for all our district hospital personnel and wish him all the best in his future endeavours and look forward to collaborating on behalf of the government to give a dignified and quality life to persons with Haemophilia.


